RFP: IP Security Camera System, 10-11

Questions:

- 1. Is the district open to adding IDF's if necessary?
 - a. While it is not likely an IDF would be created specifically for this system, the district will entertain infrastructure design modification if it is in the long term best interest of the district. The vendor will document such modifications and costs associated with the associated request in an add alternate proposal.
- 2. Can we have a soft copy of the campus maps?

- 3. Who will provide switch ports?
 - a. The district.
- 4. Are all of the campuses connected via fiber?
 - a. Yes.
- 5. What are the districts cabling standards?
 - a. The district has standardized on Systimax 700208093 2071E Plenum Cat 6 Cable Blue (23-4P UTP-CMP SOL BC Cat 6 FEP/LSPVC 550 MHZ GIGASPEED). The vendor will price with this standard end to end or better for new runs. Existing cabling can be utilized for replacement and/or upgrade solutions. Alternate materials can be submitted in an add alternate proposal.
- 6. What is the OS platform of the client computers?
 - a. Microsoft Windows, either XP Pro or 7 Pro.
- 7. Is camera access from home a requirement?
 - a. Remote access for first responders and/or security monitoring is a requirement. This does not directly mean "home", but remote access.
- 8. What is the brand of the IP cameras currently installed?
 - a. Axis.
- 9. Can we get an IP camera count by campus?
 - a. See RFP section 3.2.1 Current Inventory, and Addendum 1 for updates.

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
