1) Can we have a due date extension?

a. No.

- 2) Is this going to be CPA (Customer Provided Access) or is the service being delivered to the demarc of the building.
 - a. This service will be delivered to the demarc of the buildings identified in the RFP.
- 3) Is equipment needed for the service?
 - a. An option to provide the equipment as a Managed Service was included.
- 4) Is this a Managed Service opportunity?
 - a. A Managed Service proposal will be considered.
- 5) Do the WiFi hotspots exist today or would Sprint need to build and manage?
 - a. The WiFi hotspots do not exist today. The RFP is requesting proposals for service options to build a Community Hotspot model.
- 6) Does Pasadena ISD have a VPN concentrator or something equivalent?
 - a. Not that is allocated and sized for use with this project.
- 7) On the student connection solution (cellular) would there be a need for Static IP's?
 - a. If there is a need for static IP's based upon proposer's design, proposer may request the district to provide the required IP's as a request for district resources as part of the proposal.

- 8) Would Pasadena ISD consider a direct contract for multiple years and not transfer Home Access to the Parents after a year?
 - a. Yes. Transfer to the parents is an option and not a requirement of the proposal.
- 9) As November 11 is Veteran's Day, will the Purchasing Department be open for business on that date to accept FedEx deliveries?
 - a. Yes.
- 10) Under 3.2.2, would the district entertain a solution that provided 10M connectivity to the community hot spots back to the district NOC, but having PISD be responsible for the Wi-Fi access points themselves?

a. Yes.
