RFP #07-2012 - Virtualization, Storage, Backup

The following question and answer response addendum is a compilation of clarification items and questions submitted via email since the release of Addendum #1.

Corrections / Questions:

1. Correction to information: Page 5, Section 1.1, *“Upgrading the fiber channel switches and HBAs will also be considered.”* Replace with: It is the preference of the District to replace the existing fiber channel switches and HBA’s at the NOC and standardize on the SAN switching technology within the District at both the Data Center and the NOC.
2. HAddition. In regards to the VMware ESXi host at Brazos Crossing Administration Building identified in Section 3.1.2.1 and 3.1.2.4, the production applications will be migrated and maintained on the new server infrastructure at the Data Center and data protection provided through the proposed solution to the server infrastructure at the NOC. Capacity, migration services and licensing should be included in the proposal. Note: The Brazos Crossing server is an AMD server
3. Clarification. The production servers on the Brazos Crossing ESXI Host are listed below. Replace Table 3.1.2.4 with the table below.

4. Correction to information: Page 21, Section 3.2.3, “*The length of the single mode fiber is less than 10K.*” Replace with: 34 km or 21 miles. The estimated db Loss at 1310 is 14.40 db and the estimated db Loss at 1550 is 10.98 db.
5. Correction: On Page 24, replace Section 3.7.1 with the following information:

3.7.1.1 Schools and Libraries Program Requirements

The Schools and Libraries Program reimburses telecommunications, Internet access, and internal connections providers for discounts on eligible services provided to schools and libraries. The District will work with the selected vendor to identify Erate eligible product and services from the proposal. An Erate qualified service provider will be given evaluation points over a non-Erate provider; however, because the percentage of Erate eligible products is not the majority of this RFP response, it is not an absolute requirement to be an Erate qualified provider.

- a. The vendor will provide a Service Provider Identification Number (SPIN) from USAC as documentation that the vendor is an Erate qualified service provider.
 - b. The vendor will identify the percentage of eligibility of proposed products within the response assuming usage is ERate eligible.
 - c. Because eligibility will depend on usage, the District and the selected respondent will work together to determine actual eligibility prior to 471 submission.
6. Correction: On Page 33, Section 4.9, delete OPTIONAL. The heading will read, 4.9 Cost Summary –NOC Switch Fabric.
